START WITH THE POLICY

The [Policy on Consulting for Faculty and Members of the Faculty Bargaining Unit](#) describes how members of the faculty at members of the faculty bargaining unit (both hereafter referred to as “faculty member(s)”) may participate in consulting activities while complying with the State of Connecticut Code of Ethics, the University of Connecticut Ethics Statement, the University’s Code of Conduct and the University’s Laws and Bylaws.

WHAT IS CONSULTING?

Consulting is any activity in which the faculty member is personally compensated for providing a service while not acting as a State employee. Such work must be based on the faculty member’s professional expertise or prominence in a field, and cannot be due to their State position. Services provided to a Faculty Affiliated Company also are considered consulting even if there is no direct compensation.
