What Physicians Should Know

Open Payments is a national disclosure program that promotes a more **financially transparent** and **accountable** healthcare system.

- Drug and medical device companies must report to CMS payments or transfers of value made to healthcare providers for research, meals, gifts, and more.
- CMS publishes this data by June 30 each year on a public website: openpaymentsdata.cms.gov.
