The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law designed to protect a student's right to privacy and along with University policy, guides UConn's management and use of student records and information. UConn's FERPA training provides Faculty and Staff with information on the **University's FERPA policy**, procedures, and best practices to assist in carrying out everyday responsibilities.



FERPA Training Complete it in 6 Steps

- 1 Log into HuskyCT via lms.uconn.edu with your NetID and password
- 2 On the Institutional Homepage, scroll down to the section titled "Self-Enroll Courses and Organizations for Faculty and Staff"
- 3 Click the link "FERPA Training for Everyone"
- 4 Expand the left side menu and click the "enroll" button and click submit
- 5 On the self enrollment confirmation page, click "Ok" to continue to the course
- 6 Click the UConn FERPA Training Link to begin the course
